It's recommended that all students have the following for remote learning:

General supplies: Graphite Pencil/Mechanical Pencil, Eraser, Colored Pencils and/or Markers, Lined Paper

Laptop or desktop computer with Internet access, audio (with earbuds or speakers) and video-streaming capabilities.
