

Mesa Public Schools Native American Education Program Summer Reading Program

NAEP is hosting a summer reading program for Mesa Public School Native American students grades K-12 from May 27-June 27. Students need to come into NAEP office and complete a registration form, pickup a reading log, and books. Students are eligible for prizes when they complete their log. Come and join the summer fun!

Summer Reading Format

Kindergarten to 3rd Grade	15 minutes of reading a day for five days a week (75 min total)
4th-6th Grade	20 minutes of reading a day for five days a week (100 min total)
7th-9th Grade	25 minutes of reading a day for five days a week (125 min total)
10th-12th Grade	30 minutes of reading a day for five days a week (150 min total)

Once students complete their reading they turn in their reading log to receive their prize at the NAEP office. Prizes range from Cold Stone certificates, Harkins passes, games, toys, and more. Keep in mind that it counts when the child reads or is read to by someone else. NAEP cross streets are Country Club and Brown road.
