*(Math, Spanish and Science courses are difficult when a semester's worth of work is compressed into three weeks. Students are not encouraged to take Math or Spanish or Science courses unless they represent "retakes" or students are capable in these subjects. When taking only the 2nd semester of a Math or Spanish or Science class, for the first time, students should have earned a minimum grade of "C" in the first semester of those same classes.)*
- \$155.00 Driver Education course
- \$160.00 Behind The Wheel (BTW) - *For those students enrolled in Summer School Driver Education course. Must be at least 15 years & 7 months and have a learners permit.*
- \$165.00 Science courses
- \$150.00 Bowling course - *Plus \$45.00 payable to bowling alley for lane, shoes and ball rental.*

## STATEMENT OF AWARENESS

*Students are responsible for understanding the following standards:*

### SENIOR HIGH SUMMER SCHOOL

I understand:

- Absences are limited to 2 days (10 periods) per class.
- Each class contains 5 periods a day. Each day is equivalent to 1 week in regular school.
- Credit is withheld if more than 2 days (10 periods) are missed.
- Students are expected to remain in class the entire day.
- Students arriving to class later than 20 minutes from the time the class starts will be considered absent.
- Final exams will be given on the last day of class and will not be given prior to that day. A.M. Class Finals are 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. PM Class Finals are 9:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- All textbooks must be returned to the summer school site by the end of each course.
- The PASS/FAIL or AUDIT options will not be exercised in senior high summer school.
- There is a \$25.00 processing fee for a refund.
- Withdrawals on or before the second day of class receive a complete refund less the \$25.00 processing fee.
- Withdrawals on the third day of class or thereafter receive no refund.
- Cancellation of a class by the Community Education Department will allow a complete refund.
- Refund payments will be distributed approximately three weeks after a withdrawal.
