The following information is intended to help support the environment we have at school. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Drop-off Procedures:

There are two options for drop-off - "walker" and "driver". "Walker" means means you park and walk to the playground to drop-off your child. "Driver" means you stay in your car and drop-off your child in the loading zone on Medina. If you are parking and walking your child in, please be cautious of parking lot traffic and use the North lot at the corner of Medina and Patterson. If you are **not** parking, pull through the drop-off lane located on Medina. You must enter the line from the west and exit towards the east. Pull all the way forward before letting your child(ren) out. For the safety of our children, **do not** drop off children in the parking lot and have them walk through traffic to enter campus. Students should not be dropped off more than 10 minutes prior to the start of school due to campus supervision.

Pick-up Procedures:

There are two options for pick-up - "walker" and "driver". "Walker" means means you park and walk to the playground to pick-up your child. "Driver" means you stay in your car and pick-up your child in the loading zone on Medina. Students must be picked-up within 10 minutes of the release time. There are two options for families: park and walk to pick up your child by the playground or use the drive thru lane on Medina. Students who will be picked up by the playground area, will be waiting there with supervision. Students who will be picked up at the drive thru area will be lined up in ABC order by family in the designated fenced area on Medina. Students will only be released to a parent or a prior approved person. Students will not be allowed to roam from one pick up area to another. The teachers have radios so we can all communicate and move students safely.

Lunch:

The children at Eagleridge have the option of buying a school lunch for \$1.95 a day or bringing their lunch. The primary (K-2) students each lunch from 11:15-11:35 and then go out to play until 11:55. Lunch time varies

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based on the day of attendance for intermediate students in 3rd-8th grades. On Monday, lunch is from 12-12:30. Tuesday and Thursday, lunch is from 12:30-1:00. Wednesday and Friday lunch time is from 12:10-12:40.

Absences and Tardies:

It is expected that students attend Eagleridge on the days enrolled. If a student needs to be absent, parents are expected to call the attendance line (480) 472-3688. If your child is late, you must escort your child into the office to be checked in properly. If you plan to walk your child to class at this time, you will need to sign in and go through the visitor check in process. Tardies cause a significant disruption to the classroom environment. It is imperative to have your children at Eagleridge on time in order to maximize their opportunity, and that of others, each day.

Dress Code Standards:

Eagleridge adheres to all Mesa Public Schools' dress standard policies. According to the student Information and Guidelines, dress and grooming standards promote school pride, self-esteem, the safety and welfare of students and staff, and achievement of goals. These standards include:

- Clothing may not convey a message that
 - relates to tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs
 - appears sexually suggestive, vulgar, obscene, or offensive
 - advocates or promotes violence or expresses gang affiliation
 - threatens or intimidates another person
- Straps must be 2 inches in width.
- Midriffs may not show.
- Shirts need to have a back.
- Shorts must reach past fingertips while arms are resting at sides, or have at minimum a 2 inch inseam.
- Dresses must reach 1 inch beyond the fingertips while arms are resting at sides.
- Pants must cover all underwear and be fitted properly - no sagging.
- Hats and sunglasses are not to be worn inside buildings.
- Pajamas and sleepwear are prohibited.
- Footwear is to be worn at all times. Shoes with wheels in them are not allowed.
 - Students who have PE are required to have appropriate shoes for this class. Students are allowed to change into those shoes to participate. Without proper footwear, students will not be allowed to participate in PE.
- Hair color must be of natural hues and not cause a significant disruption to the classroom environment.
