EDISON SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS:

1. We will show respect to everyone on the school campus.
2. We will use positive, non threatening ways to solve problems as alternatives to fighting.
3. We will walk on sidewalks and stay off of the grass areas between buildings.
4. We will play safely on playground equipment.
5. We will stay clear of any water that has gathered on campus from rainy days or irrigation.
6. We will use polite, appropriate language at all times.
7. We will use our best behavior on the bus.
8. We will use good manners in the cafeteria.
9. We will walk bikes on campus, and leave skates, roller blades, and skateboards at home.
10. We will treat all school property with respect.
11. We will be safe by not throwing rocks or other dangerous objects.
12. Firearms, firecrackers, pocket knives, and other dangerous objects will not be brought to school.
13. Valuable possessions that could be lost, damaged, or disrupt the learning process will be left home, unless they are requested for a special school activity.
14. We will be on campus only during the hours of 7:40 a.m. and 2:40 p.m.
15. Candy and gum will only be consumed as part of a supervised activity.
16. We will dress in accordance with the Mesa Public School Dress Code that is stated in our student handbook.

EDISON SCHOOL BUS RULES:

1. Obey driver's instructions.
2. Keep aisles clear.
3. Remain seated until the bus stops.
4. If seats are assigned, stay in your own seat.
5. Keep everything inside the bus.
6. Talk quietly - don't yell.
7. Don't throw objects.
8. Keep hands to self.
9. Maintain appropriate conduct at bus stops, respecting neighbor's property.
10. Don't arrive earlier than 10 minutes before the bus arrives at the bus stop.
