

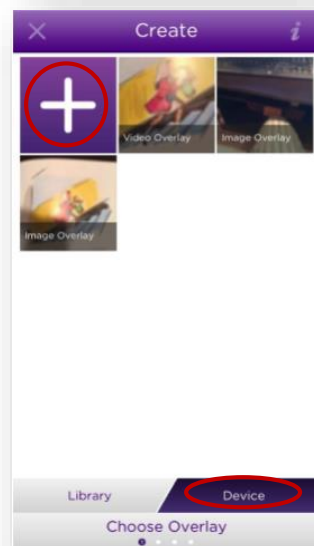
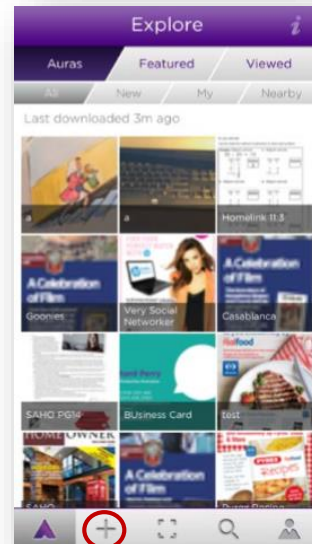
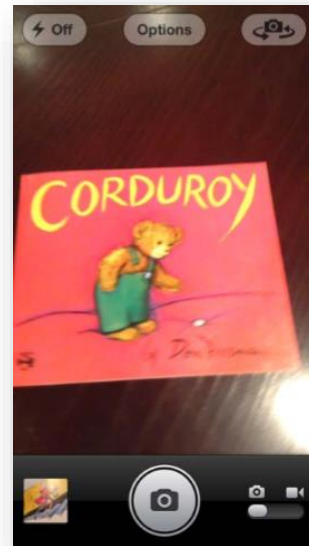
# Aurasma: Creating from Device

1. Capture an image or video using your camera on your device.
  - For video, ideal time limit is between 30 seconds to 2 minutes.

2. Open the Aurasma app on your device.

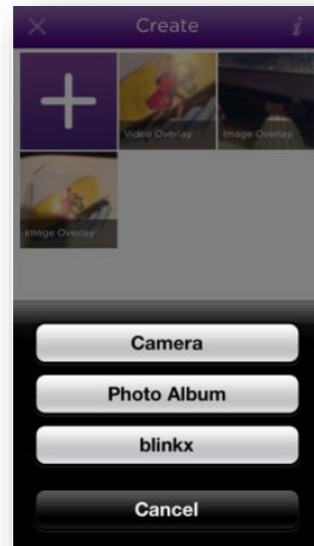
3. Select the + sign. You want to 'add' an Aura.

4. Touch the word "Device" in the bottom right hand corner and make sure it is highlighted in dark purple. Then click the big white plus inside the purple box in the upper left corner.

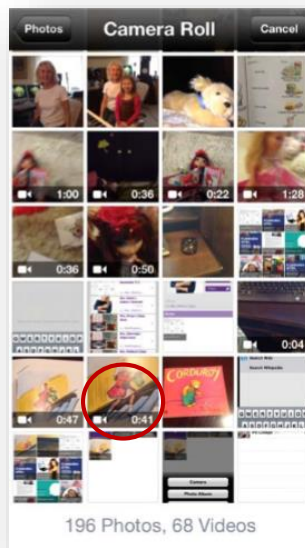


# Aurasma: Creating from Device

5. Click 'Photo Album' to use the video or image you already captured.



6. Select the video or image from your camera roll. Once you have found it select the blue Choose button.



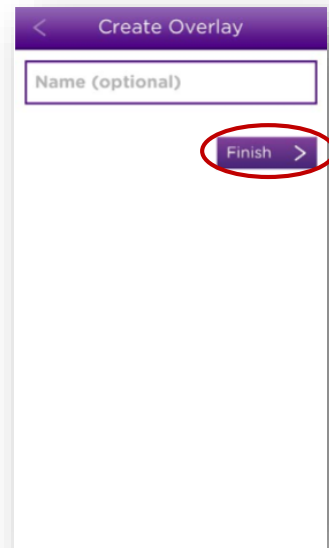
7. Wait while the video file compresses.





# Aurasma: Creating from Device

8. Name your overlay and click 'Finish.'

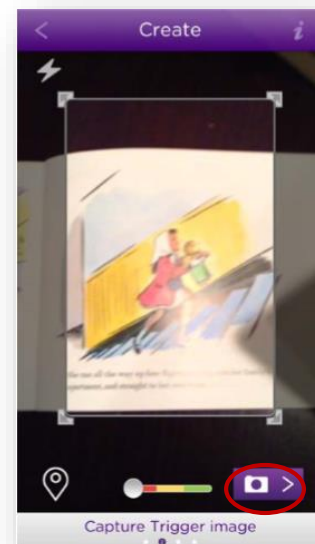


9. Click 'OK' stating that you would like to create an Aura with this Overlay.



10. Capture a trigger image.

- You want the 'energy bar' to be all the way to green. This gives you the best image possible. Try to avoid shadows or light glares on our image. You will snap a photo of the trigger image by clicking on the white camera in the purple box located in the bottom right corner.

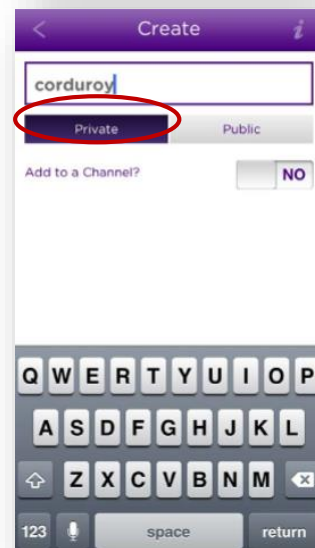
## 11. Position the overlay.

- Pinch and move the overlay. You can make it larger or smaller. You can also make it straight, diagonal and move it. We recommend putting it straight and in the center and making it a decent size. You want the content to be large enough to be seen and understood.

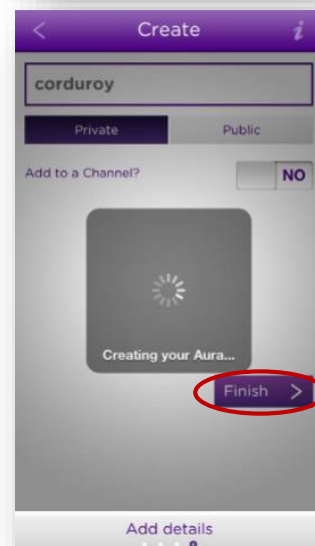


## 12. Name your Aura and choose its location.

- Give it an appropriate name and then choose if it is for Private or Public. If you want to share it with your students, you will want to make it Public and add it to a channel that they follow. Please refer to the tutorial Creating and Following Channels for more information.

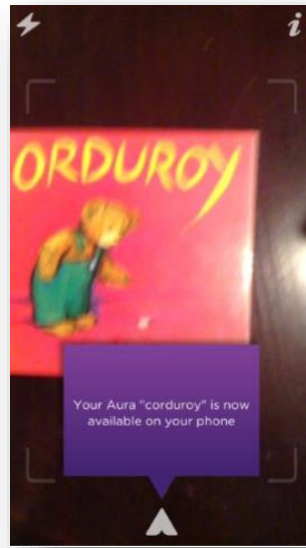


## 13. Wait for the Aura to finish. Click Finish.



# Aurasma: Creating from Device

14. Aurasma will prompt you with a pop up box informing you that your Aura is ready.



15. From the Viewer screen, hover device over the trigger image until you see the purple aura swirl.

- Your device needs to be able 12 inches away. Sometimes you may have to slightly tip the device to angle it in a different way. The purple aura will begin loading the overlay once the trigger images has been recognized.



16. Hold your device still. Make sure your volume is up. Enjoy your Aura!
