PERMIT TO LEAVE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GROUNDS

For the safety of our students, elementary schools do not permit students to leave the school grounds during school hours without written permission signed by the student’s parent or guardian and approved by the principal. Parents who permit their child to leave campus should carefully evaluate the risks, recognizing that crossing guards are not posted and the school cannot supervise students after they leave the school grounds.

If you wish for your child to leave the school grounds only occasionally, you should send a separate note each time.

If you wish for your child to leave the school grounds at the noon hour each day, please sign the form below and return it to your child’s school.

This form must be re-signed each year your child attends a Mesa school in order to continue to leave school grounds at the noon hour each day.
