I am a Child Protective Services (CPS) Investigator employed by the Salt River Pima Maricopa Indian Community (SRPMIC). Per the SRPMIC Code of Ordinances at Chapter 11, Article IV, § 11-28, as well as the Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) § 8-800 and § 8-802, CPS is mandated to investigate allegations of child abuse or neglect.

The SRPMIC Code of Ordinances at Chapter 11, Article IV, §11-27(g) authorizes CPS Investigators employed by the SRPMIC to interview a child without parental consent if there is reason to believe the child has been subject to abuse or neglect. Please do not contact the parents, guardians, or custodians of the child named above unless specifically requested or authorized by me, as the SRPMIC CPS Investigator, or by one of the SRPMIC CPS Management staff. I hereby verify that this action is consistent with applicable laws and policies pertinent to SRPMIC CPS investigations.

Because of the sensitive and confidential nature of a CPS investigation, school personnel are not permitted to be present during the interview. Additionally, pursuant to SRPMIC Code of Ordinances at Chapter 11, Article I, § 11-12(b), whatever information may have been discussed with the child cannot be disclosed to school personnel absent a court order.

Under State and Federal law, any information the school may have or may obtain during this investigation, including this form and the fact that the child named in this form was contacted by a CPS Investigator regarding allegations of abuse or neglect is confidential. Do not disseminate any information regarding this investigation to any person unless specifically authorized by applicable law or court order.

If during the course of this investigation of alleged child abuse or neglect, the CPS Investigator finds it necessary to place the child in the temporary protective custody of the SRPMIC CPS, a copy of the Notice of Removal or a temporary custody notice will be provided to the school pursuant to Chapter 11, Article IV, §11-28(d) of the SRPMIC Code of Ordinances.
