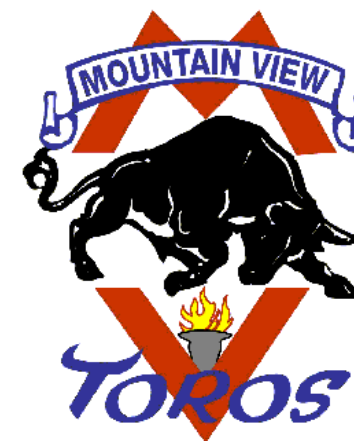

School Profile

Mountain View High School

Mountain View, a comprehensive four-year high school serving the north-central area of Mesa, Arizona, has an enrollment of 3350 students in grades 9-12. Mountain View High School is fully accredited by the State of Arizona and by the North Central Association of Schools and Colleges.

One-half credit is awarded for successful completion of each semester course. Classes are 54 minutes in length and meet 5 days per week.

Class Rank

Class rank is determined based upon the student's College Core GPA, consisting of the following credits:

4 English, 4 Math, 3 Science, 3 Social Studies, 2 World Language and 1 Fine Art.

Only the highest grades are counted.

Mountain View is a permanent voting member of the College Board.

2019 Diploma Requirements

Mesa Public Schools offers one high school diploma. A minimum of 22 units of credit is required to earn either diploma. In addition, graduates must pass the civics exam and have an Education Career Action Plan. Specific subject requirements are listed below.
