

12TH GRADE NON-RELEASE FORM FOR LUNCH

The Mesa Schools Governing Board has determined that 12th grade students “in good standing”, who have completed 16 credits and who have the permission of their parent/guardian, may leave campus for lunch in a vehicle or on foot. The Governing Board has defined “good standing”, as those 12th grade students who are taking enough classes to qualify for graduation in May of 2020. Therefore, all 12th grade students who have senior credit status will be issued an I.D. card that allows them to leave campus for lunch **unless** a parent requests that his/her student not be allowed to leave. (Please see the Non-Release form below.) Leaving campus is a privilege, and the privilege will be revoked if the guidelines for behavior are not followed. A senior student can lose their off-campus privileges by:

- Transporting an underclassman off-campus in a vehicle.
- Transporting another senior who does not have in their possession proper I.D.
- Failure to park in the designated student parking areas.
- Driving and parking cars without an appropriate school parking permit.
- Violation of other school rules.
