



ATTENTION ALL MOUNTAIN VIEW ATHLETES AND PARENTS . . .

For your student(s) to be eligible to try out for a sport at Mountain View, the following must be completed prior to tryouts:

1. Parent must register student(s) for all applicable sports on RegisterMyAthlete.com. Mountain View uses this online system of managing and tracking physicals and eligibility.

If you already have an account on Register My Athlete, you will only need to update your existing account by changing to the 2019-2020 school year and editing any information that has changed (phone numbers, etc.). If your son/daughter plans to participate in more than one sport, be sure to register for each sport now.

If you already have an account on Register My Athlete and will now have another son/daughter entering Mountain View who will be participating in sports, follow the instructions to register additional athletes.

2. Students must view the Brainbook concussion video and take the quiz that follows. The video can be viewed at <https://aiaacademy.org/>. **Please set up an account; do not log in as a guest. It causes problems.** Print a copy of the certificate of completion and hand carry it to the athletic secretary. This certificate is good for 5 years and will not need to be completed each year.
3. Students must receive a sports physical each school year. Please complete Pages 1-3 of the physical forms which can be found under the Athletic tab and take them with you to the physical. **Make sure the physician signs the bottom of Page 3 and completes and signs Page 4 before leaving their office.** Physicals will not be accepted without the signatures on both pages. Hand carry a copy to the athletic secretary. Physicals must be dated March 1st or later to be good for the following school year.

The only papers you will need to turn in to the office are the actual Health Physical forms (all 4 pages) and the Brainbook Certificate.

To be eligible and remain eligible, students must be enrolled in a minimum of 5 classes. Exceptions are available for a senior on track to graduate, who then must be enrolled in a minimum of 4 classes. Eligibility is checked according to a timeline approved by the Governing Board.
