

# Porter Elementary School Rules 2020-2021



## Rules:

1. Be Respectful-talk appropriately, follow directions first time given
2. Be Responsible-participate in learning, be organized, complete home work
3. Be Safe-keep hands, feet and other objects to yourself

## Consequences:

1. Warning
2. Time out/self-reflection
3. Loss of privileges
4. Parent contact/detention
5. Parent, teacher and principal conference

## Severe Clause:

Immediate office referral/contact principal

Example: unsafe or threatening behavior

## Positive Classroom Behavior Rewards

Tickets, stickers, daily/weekly/monthly/quarterly drawings, special jobs, certificates, treasure box, positive notes, phone calls to parents, reward jars, hall bulletin boards to post winners names, etc.....

## School Wide Rewards

Drawings (1 primary/ 1 intermediate), lunch w/ principal, quarterly recognition, Citizen of the Quarter, Golden Binder award, a community reward where classes can save their tickets up and purchase items such as a dance party with me or game /recess time with their teacher,

# Assembly Rules

## Rules:

1. Be Respectful-talk appropriately, follow directions first time given
2. Be Responsible-stand in line quietly, line up in ABC order
3. Be Safe-walking, keep hands, feet and other objects to yourself

## Procedures:

1. Enter and exit quietly
2. Sit in assigned areas
3. Sit correctly
4. Keep personal space
5. Use appropriate audience

## Consequences:

1. Verbal reminder
2. Removal to sit by teacher
3. Removal to office

## Rewards:

An enjoyable performance or experience with good friends and PBIS tickets

# Cafeteria Rules

## Rules:

1. Be Respectful-talk appropriately, follow directions first time given
2. Be Responsible-stand in line quietly, line up in ABC order
3. Be Safe-walking, keep hands, feet and other objects to yourself

## Procedures:

1. Walk to cafeteria in ABC order; students stand at entrance until student at cashier has moved
2. Move through the line/choose quickly at the salad bar
3. Sit at assigned table facing forward
4. Raise hand for any assistance
5. Clean up your own spills with rags from spill station
6. Bus your own table and floor as directed by the teacher and stay seated until excused
7. Walk out quietly for recess
8. Lunch sacks/bags will go in bucket and taken to playground

## **Consequences:**

1. Verbal reminder
2. Natural consequence
3. Detention table if you break rules
4. Eating in other location

## **Rewards:**

An enjoyable lunchtime with good friends and PBIS tickets

# **Playground Rules**

## **Rules**

1. Be Respectful
2. Be Responsible
3. Be Safe

## **Swings**

- Sit on bottom at all times
- Do not jump off swing
- Do not twist on swings
- Do not stand on swings
- Do not lay down on swings
- Do not kick dirt while on swings
- Do not stand next to a swing in use
- Do not straddle the swing and ride like horse
- Swing towards building/back and forth-Kindergarten swings towards basketball courts
- Always walk around swing area

## **Slides**

- Go up only on stairs
- Do not go down slide on belly
- Do not go down slide until the bottom of the slide is clear
- Do not walk back up the slide
- Keep the slide clean
- Go down the slide with feet first
- One person at a time

## **Monkey Bars**

- Go across one student at a time
- Do not cross on the top of the bars
- Go in one direction across the bars
- 3 body points of contact on bars at all times (2 hands and a foot or 2 feet and a hand)

## **Jungle Gym**

- No running on the jungle gym
- No climbing on the outside of the jungle gym (the bars)
- Use 3 body part rule (2 hands and a foot or 2 feet and a hand)
- No jumping off the jungle gym

## **Field Area**

- Use equipment supplied by school only
- Designated field for grade levels - students not to hang out between trees and fence area
- No walking or running through activities in session

## **Skill games**

- 3<sup>rd</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> grades only
- Aide /Active & Healthy directed games

## **Playground Procedures:**

1. Students put away equipment and line up when whistle blows – 1 minute before pick up time
2. Restroom breaks are to be taken during recess times – not after whistle blows
3. Students follow directions first time given, every time
4. Primary students play on east side of basketball court and Intermediate students play on west side of basketball court.

## **Rainy Day/Heat advisory:**

1. Morning recess will be in classrooms (approx. 5 minute breaks)
2. Lunch recess will be in the Media Center

## **Playground Consequences:**

1. Redirect behavior/verbal warning
2. Reteach expected behavior
3. Reteach, provide consequence (see below), and document with MIR (referral form to teacher)
  - a. Sit out
  - b. Cool down walk
  - c. Loss of privilege
4. After 4 MIR's in 10 days, an ODR (office referral) will be given to Principal

## **Severe Clause:**

Immediate office referral/contact principal
