

## **Roosevelt Dress Code**

The following Dress Code was created and approved by the Roosevelt SIAC.

### **Hats**

Hats, caps, hoodies, ski caps, and baseball caps may be worn on the playground. Hats of any kind are not allowed to be worn in the classroom or other buildings. Bandanas and any other gang related apparel is not allowed.

### **Shirts/Blouses/Dresses**

Inappropriate dress includes: clothing relating to violence, racial slurs, sexual innuendo, tobacco, alcohol, drugs or gangs.

No clothing may be worn that immodestly exposes the chest area either at the neck or the armhole.

No underwear of any type should be showing including times when students are standing, sitting or bending. Active students could wear shorts under skirts. Length of skirts must be below fingertips when arms are at side.

Shoulder straps must be at least one inch (1") wide, and must cover underwear. No spaghetti or string straps. A shirt may be worn under a narrow strap but must conform to above guideline. Sheer shirts are not allowed if undergarments or narrow shirt straps are visible.

### **Pants/Shorts/Skirts**

No sagging or overly baggy pants. Pant legs with unsafe width or length are not allowed.

Shorts and skirts must be long enough so they do not immodestly expose body parts when standing, sitting or bending.

Length of shorts must be below fingertips when arms are at side.

### **Shoes**

Flip flops and high heels are not encouraged. If a student's safety is questionable because of shoes, the PE teacher will make a professional judgment as to whether or not the student participates in PE.

### **Make up/fingernail/hair**

Make-up and other cosmetics should not be brought or applied at school. Hair sprays, body sprays, perfumes, and lotions also should not be brought to school. Minimally applied make-up is allowed.

Fingernails should be short enough so as not to present a safety problem or a distraction to others.

Hair should be a natural color -- no bright green, blue, orange, pink, red, purple, etc.
