##### ELA

##### Math

7th Grade Math: At least 56% of 7th grade students will be proficient or highly proficient on the 2019 AzMerit math assessment.

8th Grade Math: At least 45% of 8th grade students will be proficient or highly proficient on the 2019 AzMerit math assessment.

Algebra: 100% of Algebra student will be proficient or highly proficient on the 2019 AzMerit Algebra assessment.

Geometry:: 100% of Geometry student will be proficient or highly proficient on the 2019 AzMerit Geometry assessment.

##### Science

7th Grade Science: At least 80% of 7th grade students will be proficient (70% or higher) on the 7th grade MPS Science CRT assessment.

8th Grade Science: At least 70% of 8th grade students will be proficient or highly proficient on the 2019 AIMS Science assessment.

Self-Awareness: At least 85% of Shepherd Junior High School students will increase their self-awareness at school by recognizing and identifying their content strength and weakness on monthly grade checks.
