SKYLINE GRADPOINT TESTING PROTOCOL

- Students must test with their assigned Credit Recovery teacher or Media Center Specialist (showing photo ID)
- All testing must be done through Internet Explorer
- Students cannot have other tabs open during testing
- Students can have only handwritten notes on their desk during testing (teachers will be checking)
- All cell phones are to be OFF and stored in bags / backpacks
- Talking during tests and quizzes is not allowed
- Should students need assistance, they are to raise their hand
- Once the test is completed, students will notify their teacher so the test can be validated in the GradPoint system
- Should a student fail a test, students can review coursework, brush up on material, take more notes, and retake the test.

MPS GRADPOINT PRESCRIPTIVE GUIDELINES

- Students in credit recovery will utilize the prescriptive curriculum in GradPoint.
- Students who have failed courses (completed entire course and received an F) and are credit deficient may be placed in a GradPoint Prescriptive course.
- Required courses are available in the three core content areas: Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. Advanced level coursework will not be obtained via credit recovery.
- Students are limited to earning a maximum of three credit recovery credits through the GradPoint program.
- These GradPoint courses must appear on student transcript with the appropriate (CR) designation.
- Mesa Public Schools threshold for proficiency is 70 percent, therefore, a B or C are the only possible grades for credit recovery purpose.

MPS GRADPOINT SEQUENTIAL GUIDELINES

- Courses may only be used when a student enrolls in a comprehensive Mesa high school after the 20th day of the semester (without having transfer grades to enter a course) and course must be completed by the end of that semester.
- Must be approved by the high school administration and is for exceptional cases.
- Focus Schools may use the sequential courses for both core programming and Mesa Public Schools approved elective courses.
