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What is Title I?

Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) provides financial assistance to schools to meet the needs of academically at-risk students. The goal of Title I is to provide extra instructional services and activities which support students identified as failing or most at risk of failing the state's challenging performance standards in mathematics, reading, and writing.

A Title I schoolwide program is a comprehensive program used to upgrade the complete educational program in a Title 1 school thus raising academic achievement for all the students.

- Supplemental Computer Software (reading and math)
- Instructional Assistants for classroom push in services
- Professional Learning for teachers
- Family Support Specialist
