

International Baccalaureate (IB)

International Baccalaureate (IB) courses are available at Westwood High School. IB courses prepare students to take IB exams that are administered around the world in late spring of each school year. Students can also earn the International Baccalaureate Diploma for successful completion of the entire IB curriculum and qualifying scores on the IB exams. Students may be granted advanced placement status and/or college credit on the basis of Diploma completion and how well they perform on exams. Information regarding the IB Diploma Programme is available from the International Baccalaureate Coordinator's office at Westwood High School. Students are required to take an IB course to be eligible to take an IB exam.

Courses taken in grades 7-10 are prerequisites for students interested in the IB Diploma Programme. IB Diploma Programme courses are taken in grades 11-12. There is some flexibility for IB Diploma Programme students within the 11th and 12th grade course of study presented below. Students participating in the IB Diploma Programme at Westwood must be seeking the Diploma.
