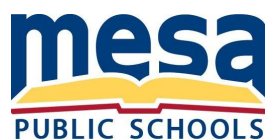

Students Entering 4th to 7th Grades

- Submit your signed *Parent/Student Letter of Commitment*.
- Provide a *Letter of Support form* to the student's current classroom English teacher and Gifted and Talented teacher (if applicable) and have the teacher forward it to Mesa Academy.
- Submit a copy of the student's most recent report card.
- All Grades - If your child is currently attending an MPS school, their Dibels/Acadience, MPS Math and Reading CRTs will be provided to the Academy by MPS.
- 6th and 7th graders - submit a copy of the student's most recent AzMERIT ELA and Math results.

Submit your signed *Parent/Student Letter of Commitment*.

Students Entering 8th Grade

- Provide a *Letter of Support Form* to the student's current English and Math teacher and have the teachers forward them to the Academy.
- Submit a copy of the student's most recent report card and AzMERIT ELA and Math results.
