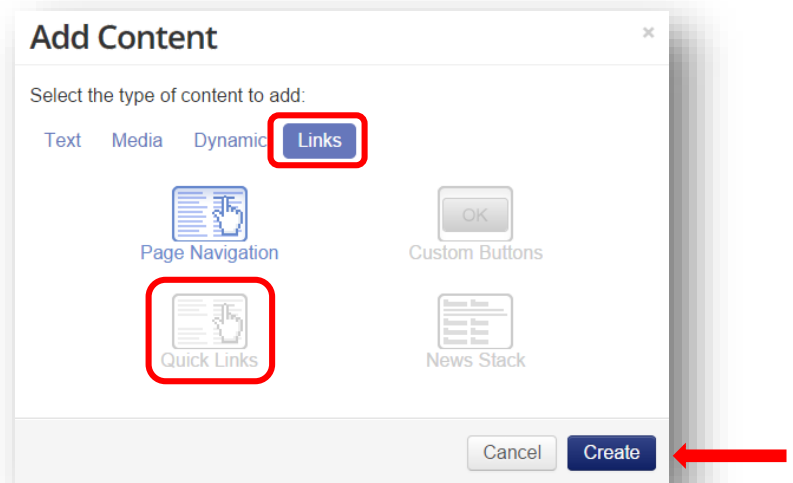
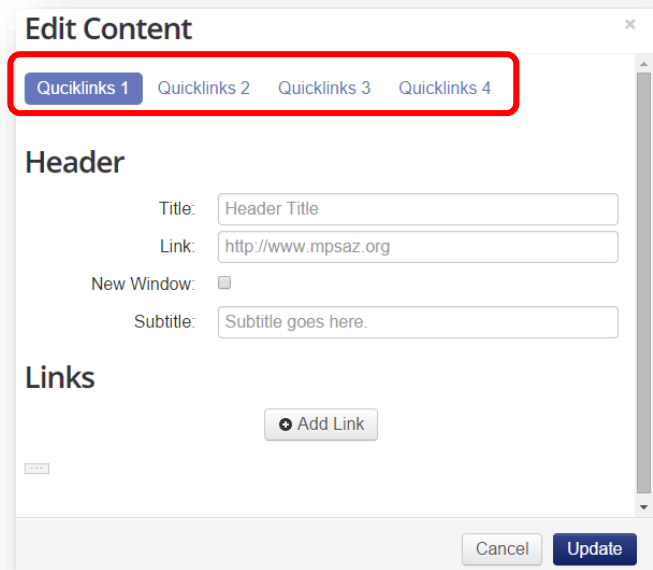


“Quick Links” is a great way to add multiple links to a content box without taking up a lot of space on your page.

Create a Quick Links box by adding a new content block in a Smart Page and select the Links tab, then Quick Links.



The Quick Links content box allows you to add links in 4 quadrants – in each corner of the box or horizontally in 4 areas of a wide box.




For each area (Quicklinks 1, 2, 3, 4) you can add a Header and then links under the Header.



To add links simply click on Add Link, add a title and the URL. Put a check mark in the New Window box for the link to open in a new page.


Repeat for more links.

You can choose to list the links or have them wrap around with a gray line between them. To do this, click on the three gray dots at the bottom left of the links.

Click on the on/off button. On will list the links, off will wrap them. Do this for each quadrant.
