Ceremony Date/Time/Location: Thursday, May 19, 2022, at 8:00 p.m. at Toro Stadium

Call Time for Graduates: All graduates must report to their assigned classroom no later than 7:15pm.

Dress Code for Graduation and Baccalaureate: Graduation is one of the most significant milestones in your life and all participants (students and staff) must dress accordingly. Appropriate attire should include a combination of:

- All attendees must wear their blue cap and gown. (*Note:* Cap mortar boards and gowns may not be decorated in any way.)
- Dress
- Skirt
- Dress slacks
- Blouse
- Collared dress shirt with tie
- Socks and dress shoes (*Note:* No stiletto heels or other shoes that may puncture the turf field).
- Please **DO NOT** wear: jeans, shorts, t-shirts, tennis shoes, or flip flops
- Additional adornments (ex: stoles, flower leis, head pieces, etc.) may not be worn during the ceremony.

Behavioral Expectations:

- Observe dress code.
- Leave your cell phone in your car or with a family member.
- Conduct yourself in a manner appropriate for such a momentous occasion.
- Refrain from the use of alcohol or illegal substances.
- Food and drinks (including water) are not permitted on the field.
- Beach balls, fireworks, horns, balloons, etc. are not permitted by graduates or attendees.

Graduates must wear a cap and gown.
- May 16 Graduation Room Assignments will be posted (Media Center)

- May 19 Graduation Rehearsal @ 7-9am (MANDATORY)
Report to your signed classrooms no later than 7am. Failure to attend rehearsal may result in not being allowed to walk in the Graduation ceremony.
- May 19 Graduation Ceremony @ 8pm
Report to your assigned classrooms no later than 7:15pm.



Additional Information:



- In order to participate in the Graduation ceremony, a student must meet all graduation requirements per Mesa Public Schools Governing Board policy.
- Students must clear all outstanding debts on their account before a diploma will be issued. Debts must be paid no later than Thursday, May 19, at 12:30pm in order for a student to receive their diploma certificate the night of Graduation.
- Graduation guests may not enter the field until the completion of the ceremony.
- Professional photographers will take a picture of each senior as they receive their diploma. Proofs will be emailed and/or mailed home approximately 5-7 days following the graduation ceremony.
