Clubs and Student Council Working Together

2022-2023

The following is information that will be useful as we work together to make this school year the best it can be.

CLUB OF THE YEAR

This award is given to the club that participates in school activities sponsored by the Student Council. The following criteria is required for the award:

- ✓ The club must be chartered (if required).
- ✓ A club representative must attend every ICC meeting – every first Thursday at 8 a.m. in Room 1215 or other date/time when notified.
- ✓ The club must participate in at least three (3) of the following school activities:
 - Club Recruitment Fair
 - Homecoming Parade
 - Tailgate Party
 - Christmas Families**
 - Running with the Bulls: Toros 5K
 - Wish week**
 - Get a minimum of 10 people to sign-up AND donate at the Fall and/or Spring blood drives.** (Be sure they say they are with your club when they sign-up.)
- ✓ A quarterly report reflecting school and service involvement must be handed in, on time, for all four quarters. The report must be emailed to the Student Council club representative - <interclub@mvtstuco.com> with pictures of your events. At least one picture per event is required. The dates of when the quarterly reports are due will be given to your ICC representative during their first meeting but are given here as a courtesy. 1st Quarter – September 29 by 3:30 p.m., 2nd quarter – December 15 by 3:30 p.m., 3rd Quarter – March 9 by 3:30 p.m., 4th Quarter – May 11 by 3:30 p.m.
- ✓ The club must participate in at least one Student Council-sponsored service project. Some of these service projects can double up as a school sponsored event.

In the case of a tie, consideration will be given to the club that has participated in the most activities, service projects, and events. The more you participate, the better your chances of winning the award.

** Service project that can count toward the school activity

If you win, the following awards will be given to your club:

- ✓ \$500 transferred directly into your club account
- ✓ Your club name on the "Club of the Year" plaque
- ✓ An individual plaque presented to your club at the annual awards assembly

CLUB BULLETIN BOARD

At a future ICC meeting, the Club Commissioner will schedule one-month blocks of time during which clubs will have the opportunity to display a bulletin board publicizing their club.

DANCE DECORATING AND CLEAN-UP

Student Council occasionally offers clubs the chance to earn \$500 by decorating and cleaning up after the Homecoming Dance and Winter Formal. Clubs will be drawn by lottery and applications will be handed out at a future ICC meeting. If your club wins the lottery, your club can earn \$500 if:

SET UP

- ✓ \$25 will be given for every student who participates in the dance set-up to 10 students max. An adult supervisor must be present. Students and adult supervisor must check-in to be counted.

CLEAN UP

- ✓ \$25 will be given for every student who participates in the dance clean up to 10 students max. An adult supervisor must be present. Students and adult supervisor must check-in to be counted.

By submitting your club for the lottery, you commit to the 10 students both before and afterwards. For each student short of 10, there will be a deduction of funds awarded.

Sadies – At the ICC in December or January, an application will be made available to clubs to work. Two or three clubs will be selected to work the dance. They will be expected to make any decorations, set-up, work the dance, and clean up. Student Council will decide the theme. The clubs selected will receive 80% of proceeds and Student Council will get 20%.

ICC MEETINGS

Interclub Council (ICC) meetings will be at **8:00 a.m. on the first Thursday of each month in Room 1215** unless otherwise noted. Please provide a pass for your club's representative as one will not be provided by Student Council. The first ICC meeting will be held on **Thursday, August 18**. We will discuss the Club Fair that is going to occur on Friday, September 2. Please tell your representative to be there on time, as we will have a lot of information to share with him/her.
