Program Specifics

- The district has been divided into 3 observation zones with approximately 28 schools from all different levels.
- Each zone is observed by 2 retired district administrators during set time periods/rounds during the school year.
- During the visit, observers score your campus in a number of categories.
 - **Operations creates the work orders for anything scored with a “1” below standards.**
- Results will be shared with you after zone is completed.
