Retesting

- To retake an assessment, you need to attend tutoring.
- To retake an assessment, you must first make up any missing work within the unit.

Redoing, Missing & Late Work

- To submit an assignment after due-date, attach a late work sheet cover sheet, which includes your name, the date submitted, the assignment name, and why the work was submitted late.
- Redoing/Missing/Late Work - You must submit late work before the next unit exam.

Incompletes & Zeros

- If a zero is input into the gradebook, there will be a comment stating the reason(s) why.

Course-Specific Weighting & Grade Categories

World History/Geography

- Points (no weighting)
- 80% = Assessments - Final Exam = 20%
 - Formative Assessments: Homework, classwork, quizzes, writing assessments, pre-tests, projects
 - Summative Assessments: End-of unit assessments (i.e.) document-based question, unit tests, midterm

American History

- Weighted categories
- Assignments = 40% - Assessments = 40% - Final Exam = 20%

AP World History & AP American History

- Points (no weighting)
- Analyzing Historical Evidence = 10% - Argument Development: 10% - History Reasoning Skills: 20% - Summative Assessments = 40% - Final Exam = 20%

Government & Economics

- Points (no weighting)
- Assignments = 30% - Assessments = 50% - Final Exam = 20%
