Dear Seniors:

The faculty and staff of Skyline High School have the privilege to honor you at a commencement ceremony on Thursday, May 20, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in the Skyline Stadium.

TICKETS

Each graduate will receive 4 tickets for graduation. Please contact AP if additional disabled/elderly/handicapped seating is needed.

CAPS, GOWNS & HONOR CORDS - Caps and gowns will be available starting on **Friday, May 7th** in the bookstore during lunches through graduation day. If you have a debt, your cap and gown will be held until the debt has been cleared. If you have not ordered your cap and gown, you can still order one at azbalfour.com or you can purchase a cap and gown in the bookstore after Friday, May 7th for a price set by Balfour, cash or money order only (NO CHECKS). Caps and gowns are yours to keep and you do not have to return them. Seniors earning a 3.50 cumulative GPA or College Core Average as of January 18th, may wear honor cords. The honor cords can be purchased in the bookstore starting **Friday, May 7th** for \$14.

SCHOLARSHIP AND AWARDS ASSEMBLY - The Scholarship and Awards assembly will be **Monday, May 10th** beginning at **6:00 pm** in the auditorium. Parents of students who will be receiving awards will be invited.

GRADUATION PRACTICE - Commencement practice will begin at **6:00 a.m., Thursday, May 20th** in the gym. Graduates need to arrive at 6:00 a.m. All graduating seniors are expected to attend this practice. You may wish to bring sunglasses and a hat for practice. Rehearsal will last approximately 1 hour.

GRADUATION - Commencement will begin at **7:00 p.m., Thursday, May 20th**, on the Skyline football field. Seniors are to line up in the **GYM** at **6:00 pm**. Stadium gates will open for seating at 5:30 pm.

- Grad Images will take pictures, and you will receive a packet of information in the mail.
- After the ceremony, seniors will receive their actual diploma from their line leader before leaving the field. Please remember to pick up your diploma before leaving the football field that evening.
- No one will be allowed to participate in the commencement program unless they have met **ALL** graduation requirements.

DEVICE/TEXTBOOK RETURN

Seniors are scheduled to return their devices/books in the Media Center on Friday, May 14th during their English classes. At graduation practice on Thursday, May 20th, a list of seniors who still owe debts or textbooks to the bookstore will be posted. When **ALL** debts are taken care of in the bookstore, students get clearance for graduation. The bookstore will be open immediately following graduation practice for seniors to clear their debts.

DRESS CODE FOR GRADUATION

All graduates must be dressed in their cap and gown for the ceremony. Underneath the gown, young men should wear slacks and a dress shirt, socks and dress shoes. Young ladies should wear a dress or nice slacks and dress shoes (low heel). No corsages on the gown itself. No decorating caps.
