CURFEW FOR MINORS

It is unlawful for a minor to be in, or upon a public street, sidewalk, alley, right-of-way, or other public place in the City if:

Under the age of SIXTEEN (16) between the hours of ten (10:00) P.M. and five (5:00) A.M.

between the ages of SIXTEEN (16) and EIGHTEEN (18) years old between the hours of twelve (12:00) midnight and five (5:00) A.M.

The provisions of this Section do not apply:

- To legally emancipated minors.
- To minors who are accompanied by a parent, guardian, or other person having legal care and custody of the minor.
- To minors who are in the pursuit of a lawful trade, occupation, work, business, or profession.
- If their presence is necessitated by an emergency, medical or otherwise, involving themselves or another.
- If their presence is due to attendance at or return from functions sponsored by or related to religious, school, civic, or nonprofit organizations.
- If the minor had permission prior to the date and time of the offense, authorizing the minor to be at a specific location.

PENALTY:

Any person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) or by imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months, or by both fine and imprisonment.
