Junior Checklist

(some things to do this summer)

- Start a senior year folder where you can keep track of everything related to college and scholarship applications.
- University bound students - register for an upcoming ACT/SAT
 - Due to COVID-19, check ACT.org or SAT.org for the updates on testing dates
 - When you register, you can send your scores to 4 prospective colleges for free
- Explore options, opportunities, and programs at Maricopa Community Colleges.
- Make a list of schools you plan on applying to, including your reach schools and safe schools.
- Check out admission requirements at the schools you are considering.
- Be a campus explorer - plan on visiting prospective colleges.
 - MANY schools are offering virtual tours and informational meetings.
- Work a summer job to expand your experiences and to earn money for college.
- Create/update your resume.
- If you are an athlete who plans on playing in college register on the NCAA website.
- Create an account on the Common Application website if your prospective school is a common app. school.
- Continue volunteering in the community.
- Begin to develop a financial aid plan on how you will pay for college.
- Look at the MPS Scholarship Bulletin and make a list of potential scholarships you might apply for next year.
- APPLY to in-state universities - look for school specific applications to open beginning JUNE 1st. (do not use the Common Application for in-state schools)
